

Ponlok Chomnes' Events



The Asia Foundation Ponlok Chomnes: Data and Dialogue for Development in Cambodia program in collaboration with its core partners and emerging research partners held the first Ponlok Chomnes National Policy Forum on "Cambodia's COVID-19 Recovery Pathways" on November 23-24, 2021, in Phnom Penh. This was a blended event which convened over 100 participants, including government representatives, researchers, civil society, policymakers, policy experts, and members of academia. Panelists presented and discussed their research findings and case studies on various topics ranging from the adoption of technology, urban and economic development, social inclusion, and foreign policy, all of which contribute to Cambodia's COVID-19 recovery plan.

With support from the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT), The Asia Foundation's Ponlok Chomnes: Data and Dialogues for Development in Cambodia program and KAFDOC co-organized a Virtual Policy Talk on "Learning Challenges and School Dropouts in Kratie Province" on October 27, 2021 via Zoom. The objective of the Policy Talk was to disseminate and discuss the findings of a study on Learning Challenges and School Dropouts in Kratie Province, which was undertaken between February 2020 and February 2021 in 15 primary schools in three districts in Kratie province.



Policy Pulse is an initiative of The Asia Foundation, founded in 2015 and formerly known as the Reform Inventory Initiative. It aims to improve the public's understanding of important policy reforms in Cambodia through high-quality research. Policy Pulse promotes thoughtful and inclusive policy dialogue and analysis in order to establish a resource for evidencebased policy recommendations. It is platform through researchers and stakeholders can gather to organize policy forums at the national and provincial levels to disseminate research and facilitate broad policy discussions.



Policy Updates from Ministries

Royal Government of Cambodia

The <u>Royal Government of Cambodia</u> has approved and implemented the law on Public-Private Partnerships in November 2021.

Ministry of Planning

The <u>Ministry of Planning</u> has recently revised the national poverty line and the poverty rate using data from the Cambodia Socio-Economic Survey 2019-2020.

Ministry of Land Management

The Ministry of Land Management, Urban Planning and Construction has released a ministerial decision on November 28, 2021 on the establishment of a working group to monitor and investigate into flooded forestland around the Tonle Sap Lake in Kampong Chhnang, Pursat, Battambang, Banteay Meanchey, Siem Reap, and Kampong Thom province.

COVID-19 Response Updates

The <u>Ministry of Tourism</u> issued an official press release confirming that there is no requirement for quarantine for fully vaccinated travelers, dated November 15, 2021.

The <u>Ministry of Health</u> issued a decision on new procedures without quarantine for incoming travelers to Cambodia, dated November 16, 2021.

The <u>Ministry of Education</u>, <u>Youth and Sports</u> on November 17, 2021 released safety measures for the annual high school diploma exams set to take place on December 27, 2021.

The <u>Ministry of Health</u> has published a press release notifying the public about a new COVID-19 variant, Omicron, found in South Africa by the WHO, dated November 27, 2021.

The <u>Ministry of Health</u> issued a decision to ban travelers from 10 African countries or who had a history of travelling to those countries in the last three weeks on November 29, 2021.









The Ministry of Health issued Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) to manage passengers arriving at Cambodian International Airports in the context of the 'new normal' during the COVID-19 pandemic on December 05, 2021.

The Ministry of Health and the World Health Organization (WHO) released a joint statement on COVID-19 Omicron update on December 09, 2021.
