On 19 January 2022, The Asia Foundation and Komar Rikreay Association - KMR co-organized a Dissemination Workshop on "Action Research Finding on The Impact of COVID- 19 on Child Protection and Wellbeing in Battambang Province," via Zoom, to present findings resulting from the research study undertaken by Komar Rikreay Association, and to seek comments and recommendations to improve children's protection and well-being in Battambang province.



The Asia Foundation's Ponlok Chomnes and the Centre for Policy Studies co-hosted a Policy Talk on "Labour Shortage and Challenges in Workers Recruitment in Agricultural Sector" on 21 January 2022, to disseminate the findings and discuss policy implication concerning labour shortages and employers' challenges in recruiting workers in agricultural sector.



This study has been undertaken to provide a contemporary and comprehensive understanding of the public policy process, and of data use and data governance in Cambodia within the context of post-COVID-19 recovery and ASEAN.



The Ministry of Health issued an announcement that home treatment is not allowed for Omicron Patients, dated January 05, 2022.

The Ministry of Health issued additional notice on increasing vaccination facilities for the fourth booster dose of COVID-19 Vaccine in Phnom Penh, dated January 10, 2022.

The <u>Ministry of Tourism</u> issued a decision on the implementation guidelines on Dos and Don'ts for international travelers who enter Cambodia, dated January 10, 2022.
