


Ponlok Chomnes' Events



The Asia Foundation's Ponlok Chomnes program and Vicheasthan Bomreu Neak Samrabsamroul Karngea Akphiwat Institute (VBNK) conducted a Virtual Dissemination Workshop on April 21, 2022. The workshop presented draft findings on "The ICT Challenges of Including the Voices of Marginalized Citizens in Democratic Decision-making Processes in Cambodia Arising from COVID-19 Conditions in the Country."



On 04 April 2022, The Asia Foundation in collaboration with the Ministry of Economy and Finance, Future Forum, and Angkor Research, and Consulting, conducted a series of workshops entitled "From

Knowledge to Policy: Unpacking Survey Findings on the Impacts of COVID-19 on Vulnerable Households in Cambodia" to discuss the draft policy brief on Impacts of COVID-19 on Poverty and Cash Transfer Program.

On 10 April 2022, The Asia Foundation's Ponlok Chomnes program kicked off SheThinks Network's first training on "Strong Proposal Writing" with its members. The training aimed to equip the Network members with problem and objective analysis skills; project design; detailed implementation plan; and comprehensive proposal budget writing.

On May 06, 2022, SheThinks Network held a blended quarterly meeting with around 20 members to discuss the future structure of the Network and its next sixmonth workplan. One of the key outcomes of the meeting was the creation of sub-committees to work on planned activities such as the podcast, speaker, and blog writing series.



The Asia Foundation's Ponlok Chomnes program hosted the first SheThinks Networking Event on May 31, 2022, convening over 20 women researchers, the Network's Advisory Council, and women leaders from various organizations in Cambodia to get to know each other and discuss relevant topics that concern their areas of research. As the network continues to grow, a number of sub-committees have been established and leads of the sub-committee members presented their workplans to the larger group.

On June 29, 2022, The Asia Foundation's Ponlok Chomnes program and the Center for Khmer Studies (CKS) co-hosted a virtual policy talk on "Sihanoukville Urban Development, Socio-Economic Change, and Transformation in the era of COVID-19."



The Ministry of Health issued a notice on the protection and prevention of the spread of COVID-19 during the upcoming Khmer New Year, dated April 01, 2022.

The Ministry of Health issued news release on the additional COVID-19 vaccination sites from April 13 to 17, 2022, during Khmer New Year holidays, dated April 04, 2022.

The Ministry of Health issued an announcement on the launch of the COVID-19 vaccination campaign for those who have not received the COVID-19 booster dose (both third and fourth dose), dated April 12, 2022.

The <u>Ministry of Tourism</u> issued a Notification adjusting the COVID-19 quarantine requirement for the international travelers who are not vaccinated or fully vaccinated, dated April 21, 2022.
