The Asia Foundation's Ponlok Chomnes Program is delighted to host <u>Ponlok Chomnes Partner Appreciation Event</u> on Tuesday, 20 June 2023. This event aimed to recognise the contribution of Cambodia's knowledge sector actors, and to deepen network among the knowledge sector actors.

The Asia Foundation's Ponlok Chomnes Program, in collaboration with its research partners, co-hosted the **Knowledge** Exchange and Dialogue on "Enhancing Public Service Sector for Vulnerable Groups in Cambodia" on April 27, 2023. The event welcomed about 120 participants (about 30% women), representing governmental and non-governmental agencies. local disabilities. organisations, persons with private sector, young students, academia. The event was conducted to share ideas and insights regarding the opportunities and challenges for vulnerable groups in accessing public services in Cambodia.










## **Publications**
